What is Happening?

The City of Howell received a portion of funding from the Federal Government and the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) to reconstruct E. Sibley Street from Michigan Avenue to National Street.

This project will include street reconstruction implementing traffic calming measures and pedestrian circulation. It will also accommodate new water main, sanitary sewer and storm sewer.

Once the project is awarded by MDOT, the City will become the local agency that manages the project.
