

HURON VALLEY FEDERAL AID COMMITTEE MINUTES
July 17, 2024 - 11:00 A.M.
Livingston County Road Commission

1. Roll Call and Introductions

Steve Wasylk, Managing Director of the Livingston County Road Commission, called the meeting of the Huron Valley Federal Aid Committee (HVFAC) to order at 11:00 a.m. A sign-in sheet was circulated, and all attendees introduced themselves. The sign-in sheet is included as Attachment A of these minutes.

3. Approval of Minutes

- Meeting of March 27, 2024

Michael Sedlak from Green Oak Township moved to approve the minutes as presented for the meeting of March 27, 2024. Erv Suida from the City of Howell supported the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

4. 2026-2029 TIP

- Discussion of Potential Projects

Steve Wasylk began the discussion by outlining the project submittal process and schedule for the 2026-2029 TIP. Mr. Wasylk stated that although the Road Commission was designated to receive the urban funding for 2027-2029 per the HVFAC Rules of Procedure, he would be open to project requests from other municipalities for those years. Erv Suida from the City of Howell and Marcel Goch from the City of Brighton both discussed potential projects under their respective jurisdictions. Additionally, Adam Baranski from LETS requested increased funding for bus purchases due to rising prices.

Mr. Wasylk and Cathy Elliott from the Village of Fowlerville then discussed potential projects for the 2026-2029 rural funding. Ms. Elliott stated that the Village was planning a large project on Grand River Avenue and requested rural funding for 2027 and 2028. Mr. Wasylk agreed with the request and stated that the Road Commission would identify a project for 2029.

Committee members discussed the proposed projects and offered suggestions for additional projects. Mr. Wasylk concluded by requesting that all estimates and Priority Rating Worksheets be submitted for Funding Committee review by late

August/early September. Mr. Wasylk commented that the final list of projects could be available for full-Committee vote at the next quarterly meeting.

5. Report from Livingston Essential Transportation Service (LETS)

Adam Baranski from LETS reviewed the prices for bus acquisitions and provided detailed cost estimates. Mr. Baranski then summarized their recent activities at the Taste of Brighton event and indicated that their shuttle service for the occasion experienced significant ridership.

6. Report from Southeast Michigan Council of Governments (SEMCOG)

Michele Fedorowicz from SEMCOG informed the Committee that SEMCOG was currently involved in the FHWA recertification process. Ms. Fedorowicz commented that the process was open to the public and discussed ways to attend the procedures for anyone interested. Ms. Fedorowicz then reviewed the TIP development process and commented that the funding targets for the 2026-2029 TIP should be available soon. Lastly, Ms. Fedorowicz stated that the call for CMAQ and Carbon Reduction projects would be in early October and noted that the call would close December 9th.
